ACCOMMODATION: 3 nights in Tbilisi, 1 Night in Gudauri

Day 1: Tbilisi

- Arrival in Tbilisi.
- Transfer and check-in at the hotel. (Overnight in Tbilisi).
- Welcome dinner at the restaurant with show program of national dances. (Overnight in Tbilisi).

Meals included: Dinner

Day 2 Tbilisi – Ananuri-Gudauri-Kazbegi-Gudauri

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- departure to Aragvi Valley via military road. On the way, we will visit **Fortress Ananuri.** It is not only a historical place, but from here, you can also see the **Zhinvali reservoir** with an amazing panoramic view.
- Departure to famous ski resort **Gudauri**-photo shooting.
- Drive to Stephantsminda.
- Walk to Gergeti church. The church is situated on the right bank of the **river Chkheri**, at an elevation of 2170 meters (7120 feet), under Mount Kazbegi. The church, lonely staying of the top of the mountain, surrounded with a breathtaking landscape, is one of most famous Georgian landmarks. (a vehicle is available for those who prefer not to walk).
- For lunch we will visit a local Family. For fans of mountains, Caucasus nature and travelling, It will be interesting to wrap with own hand khinkali and a pkhlovana (khachapuri with greens), this journey will become true pleasure.
- Check-in at the hotel. (Overnight in Gudauri)

Meal plan: Breakfast, Lunch with culinary master-classes

Distance: Tbilisi-Ananuri 70 km., Ananuri-Gudauri 60 km. Gudauri-Kazbegi – 40 km.

DAY 3: Gudauri-Uplistsikhe-Mtskheta-Tbilisi

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Check out from the hotel.
- Transfer to the cave city Uplistsikhe.
- This mysterious place is called Uplistsikhe. Its history dates back to the II-I millennium BC.
- In the era of Late Antiquity, it was a thriving and influential religious, political and cultural center. We will walk along the streets carved into the rock, pass magnificent cave temples, halls, dwellings and utility rooms.
- People finally abandoned this settlement only in the 19th century AD. Ages ago this amazing city was consisted of more than 700 underground premises, but only 150 have reached our days.

- Transfer for lunch in a wine cellar "Saguramo".
- During the lunch, guests will be given a master classes on preparation of a Khinkali, we will try domestic wine!
- After lunch our excursion will continue in the ancient city museum of Mtskheta!
- Excursion in the former capital city of Mtskheta, being the religious center of Georgia.
- Mtskheta is one of the oldest cities of Georgia (in Kartli province of Eastern Georgia), near Tbilisi. Mtskheta was a capital of the Georgian Kingdom of Iberia during the 3rd century BC 5th century AD. Here Georgians become converted to Christianity in 317 and Mtskheta still remains the headquarters of the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church.
- **Jvari Monastery** is a Georgian Orthodox monastery of the 6th century near Mtskheta (World Heritage site), Mtskheta-Mtianeti region, eastern Georgia. The name is translated as the Monastery of the Cross. For another, Jerusalem-located Georgian monastery with the same name.
- Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, built in the 11 th century. Though the site itself is even older dating back to the early 4th century and is surrounded by a number of legends associated primarily with the early Christian traditions. Svetitskhoveli, known as the burial site of Christ's mantle, has long been the principal Georgian church and remains one of the most venerated places of worship to this day. The church counts UNESCO world heritage sites.
- Transfer to Tbilisi. (Overnight in Tbilisi)

Meal plan: Breakfast, Lunch

Distance: Kazbegi - Tbilisi 180 km.

Day 4: Tbilisi

- Breaksfast at the hotel.
- Explore the capital of Georgia, Tbilisi and wander the old districts of the city with its narrow streets, patterned balconies and colorful houses.
- Walking tour in the old part of Tbilisi.
- Coming to Georgia and not visiting the famous Tiflis sulfur baths is like visiting France and not visiting the Eiffel Tower! That is why we offer: optionally Visit the sulfur baths. Free time to explore on your own.
- 19:00 Farewell dinner at the restaurant with show program (*Overnight in Tbilisi*)
